### Jess Ranch Community Disaster Response

Thank you to the several who have expressed their interest to join our team, we just need to get them trained for the position they choose.

#### This is our structure

- 1, Residents who are responsible for keeping their personal supplies emergency ready. Assess our property for damage or potential problem. Keep your red flag in a easy accessible place. Check in at your gathering place.
- 2. Block Captains know your 15-22 people assigned to you and any special needs they may have. In an event pull your people together and develop a survival team if we get to that point [Training necessary]
- 3. Zone Captain your block Captains with your Zone report to you and are kept up to date by you. Zone Captains communicate with their Division Commander any pertinent information and debriefing.
- 4. Division Commanders and Treatment Area Commander aka DC 12, DC 45, C 36 and TAC. They transmit info from the field area they cover to the FOC [Field Operation Commander] and at times the TAC will transmit direct to the Fire Distract Command Bus.
- 5. Logistics Transports supplies and patient via golf carts. They are assigned to a zone
- 6. Durable Equipment: various hospital, health care equipment are loaned our to residents.
